It will be a daily responsibility of each child, as part of their homework, to check the pencil case to make sure the following items are available every day: Fiskars scissors, protractor, yellow highlighter, pencil sharpener and at least 4 sharpened pencils. In addition, the student will need set of colored pencils, glue stick and box of markers. **It is the student's responsibility to sharpen pencils and replenish supplies as needed.**
