Tuesday: Celebrating Your Nation

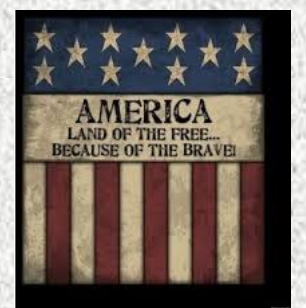
- Students will honor our U.S. military by writing letters to Father Dundon's Marines
