Boys bring: 1 plastic shoe box bin

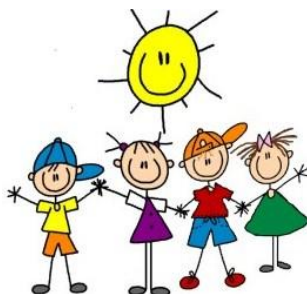
