 1 package solid-color cupcake liners

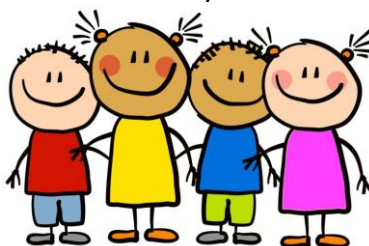
Boys bring: 1 colored Sharpie
