Girls bring: 1 bag of dried beans (any type)

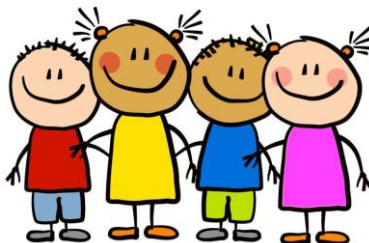
Boys bring: 1 can of shaving cream

 1 gallon bubbles

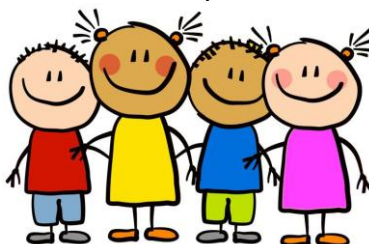
Boys bring: 1 box of 5 oz. Dixie cups
