

## Three-Year-Old Preschool Supply List Tuesday and Thursday Mornings 2024-2025

Students purchase their **STCS Tiger shirts, hoodies, and a tote bag** through our online store at [sainttimothysales.company.site](http://sainttimothysales.company.site) Items will be picked up at the “Come and Visit Day” on August 22nd. Kids will also wear khaki pants/shorts/skorts (from any store) and **Velcro sneakers**. Feel free to add a cute key chain, name tag, or painted name to the tote for identification. (Backpacks not allowed.)

Bring to Come and Visit Day:

- Your child’s original birth certificate so that we can verify it for licensing requirements.
- Complete change of non-uniform clothes (including socks and underwear) in a large Ziploc bag labeled with child’s name.
- Paper lunch bags (Keep these at home and use them for sending in your child’s snack each class. No lunch boxes or water bottles please. Kids will be provided with cups of water.)
- 1 package of baby wipes in September (and 1 in January as well)
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 bag of dried chick peas (not canned) for our sensory table
- 1 box of shaped pasta (bowtie, shell, rigatoni etc.)
- 1 disposable plastic tablecloth
- 1 container of foaming hand soap (not coconut)
- 1 4x6 family photo
- 1 current individual picture (4 x 6 or smaller)
- 1 box of 5 ounce Dixie cups (not 3 ounce). We’ll use them at snack.
- 6 containers of Play Doh (on Amazon; cans should be 4 oz each, not smaller)
- 1 package of Ziploc snack bags

Girls bring:

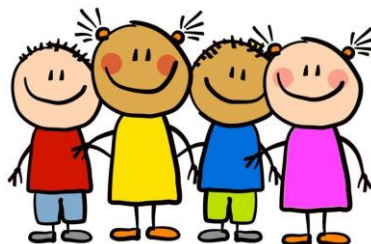
- 1 package of balloons

Bring to Come and Visit Day:

- Your child’s original birth certificate so that we can verify it for licensing requirements.
- 1 insulated lunch box (for lunch and two snacks) labeled with name. (bring on 1<sup>st</sup> day of school)
- 1 water bottle with a straw top labeled with your child’s name brought daily to school. (1<sup>st</sup> Day)
- 1 very small stuffed animal for rest time left at school Monday-Friday.
- 1 muslin blanket left at school Monday-Friday. (Large fuzzy blankets will not fit in the cubby.)
- A jumbo size (18”x18”) reusable shopping bag labeled with the child’s name. (Used for transporting the nap mat home for washing on Fridays. (No Ziplocs/backpacks please. HomeGoods has them.)
- 2 complete changes of non-uniform clothes (including socks and underwear) in separate gallon Ziploc bags labeled with child’s name.
- 3 packages of baby wipes
- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 1 disposable tablecloth from the dollar store
- 2 Mr. Clean Dry Magic Erasers
- 12 containers of Play Doh (on Amazon; cans should be 4 oz each, not smaller)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 4 small glue sticks (color-changing preferred)
- 1 box of jumbo crayons
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 current individual picture (4 x 6 or smaller)
- 2 4x6 family pictures (very important if your child is missing you)
- 1 package of stickers (prefer non-licensed)
- 1 package of sidewalk chalk
- 3 bags of any dry beans (not kidney beans)
- 1 package of corn starch
- 1 package of 5 oz cups (not 3 oz.)
- 1 package of inexpensive small white paper plates

Girls bring: 1 package of sandwich Ziploc bags (non-slider)

Boys bring: 1 package shaped pasta (bowtie, shell, rigatoni etc.)
